AN ACT

RELATING TO EDUCATION; PROVIDING FOR INSTRUCTION RELATING TO THE NATURE AND EFFECTS OF ALCOHOL, TOPACCO AND NARCOTIC AND DANGER-OUS DRUGS ON THE HUMAN SYSTEM, AND AMENDING SECTION 15-1023, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:
 Section 1. Legislative intent

3 The legislature intends by this act to strengthen and ex-

4 pand the existing course of instruction in common and high
5 schools which emphasizes and insures desirable health habits,
6 attitudes and knowledge of the effects of alcohol and narcotics
7 upon the physical, mental and emotional development of persons
8 by including in such course the same instruction on the nature
9 and effects of tobacco and dangerous drugs, including the plant
10 cannabis and all substances and parts of the plant.
