## AN ACT

RELATING TO COUNTIES; PRESCRIBING THE METHOD OF FILLING A VACANCY FOR THE OFFICE OF SUPERVISOR, AND AMENDING SECTION 11-213, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:
- Section 1. Purpose
- 3 The purpose of this act is to alter the method of filling
- 4 a vacancy in the office of county supervisor by releaving the
- 5 clerk of the board from participating in filling the vacancy
- 6 and substituting the presiding judge of the superior court in
- 7 the county to assist in the selection.
- 8 Sec. 2. Section 11-213, Arizona Revised Statutes, is
- 9 amended to read:
- 10 11-23. Election; vacancies
- A. At the general election for state and county officers,
- 12 one supervisor shall be elected from each district from among
- 13 those nominated at the preceding primary election. They shall
- included at the processing primary organization.
- 14 be nominated and elected by the qualified electors of their re-
- 15 spective districts. If a supervisor moves from the district from
- 16 which he was elected his office shall at once become vacant.
- B. Whan a vacancy occurs in the office of supervisor, the
- 18 remaining supervisors, together with the eleck-of-the-beard-of
- 19 emperviours PRESIDING JUDGE OF THE SUPERIOR COURT IN THE COUNTY
- 20 IN WHICH THE VACANCY OCCURS, shall fill the vacancy by appoint-
- 21 ment of a resident of the district in which the vacancy occurred.
