AN ACT

RELATING TO STATE GOVERNMENT; PROHIBITING THE MULTIPLE READING OF A BILL IN THE STATE LEGISLATURE; AMENDING TITLE 41, CHAPTER 7, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY ADDING ARTICLE 5.1, SECTION 41-1178, AND PROVIDING FOR CONDITIONAL ENACTMENT.

- Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:
- Section 1. Title 41, chapter 7, Arizona Revised Statutes,
 - is amended by adding article 5.1, section 41-1178, to read:
