AN ACT

RELATING TO PROFESSIONS AND OCCUPATIONS; PROVIDING FOR EMPLOYMENT OF EXAMINERS BY BOARD OF COSMETOLOGY; PROVIDING THAT ISSUANCE OR RENEWAL OF LICENSES UNDER CERTAIN CONDITIONS BE AT DISCRETION OF BOARD, AND AMENDING SECTIONS 32-503 AND 32-552, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES.

- l Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:
- 2 Section 1. Purpose
- 3 The purpose of this act is to permit the employment of ex-
- aminers to assist the board of cosmetology in examining applicants
- 5 for licensure, and to leave issuance or renewal of licenses under
- 6 certain conditions to the discretion of the board rather than the
- 7 now existing mandatory denial of issuance or renewal of such
- 8 licenses.
- 9 Sec. 2. Section 32-503, Arizona Revised Statutes, is
- 10 amended to read:
- 32-503. Organization; meetings; compensation; personnel
- A. The board shall select a president, vice president and
- 13 secretary-treasurer from among its membership. The president
- 14 shall preside at meetings of the board and shall act as the chief
- 15 administrative officer of the board, except as in this chapter
- 16 otherwise specified. The vice president shall perform the duties
- 17 of the president in absence or disability of the president and
- 18 shall perform such other duties as may be prescribed by the board.
- 1) The duties of the secretary-treasurer shall be as prescribed by
- 20 this chapter.

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- 1 The board shall hold annual meetings on the second Monday of January of each year in the city of Phoenix, at which time the board shall select its officers as provided in this The board may hold other meetings from time to time and at such places as shall be designated in the call therefor which meetings may be held upon call of the president of the board or a majority of its members pursuant to reasonable notice thereof 7 sent to each member, unless such notice is waived by all board members. A majority of the board shall constitute a quorum for 10 the purpose of exercising all the powers and duties of the board. The board shall maintain suitable offices for the conduct of its 11 12 business.
- C. Each member of the board shall receive compensation as determined pursuant to section 38-611. The members shall devote their full time in performing their duties as members of the board.
- D. The board may employ inspectors, EXAMINERS and clerical help necessary to carry out the provisions of this chapter, who compensation shall be as determined pursuant to section 38-611.
- 20 E. All compensation and expenditures authorized by this 21 chapter shall be paid from the board of cosmetology fund within 22 the limitation of the annual general appropriation bill.

The board shall not issue or renew, and may suspend or 28 revoke, a license already issued, for any one or more of the 29 following: •auses+

- Conviction of a felony UNLESS THE PERSON HAS SERVED
 THE SENTENCE IMPOSED OR HAS BEEN PARDONED OR PAROLED.

 Malpractice or incompetency.
- 33. Affliction of an applicant or licensee with an infec 34 tious, contagious or communicable disease.
- 4. Advertising by means of knowingly false r deceptive _____
 36 statements.

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- 5. Advertising, practicing or attempting to practice under a name or trade name other than the one in which the license
- 3 certificate is issued.
- 4 6. Habitual drunkenness or the habitual use of morphine,
- 5 cocaine or other habitual drugs.
- 7. Commission of any offense enumerated in section 32-551.
- Violation of any health regulation promulgated by a
- 8 state or local board of health or violation of any sanitary reg-
- 9 ulation promulgated by the state board of cosmetology in accordance
- 10 with the standards of such boards of health.

- 12 10. Wilfully making a false statement on which the board
- 13 relies or acts.
