AN ACT

RELATING TO COUNTIES; AUTHORIZING CREATION OF JOINT OFFICES OF PUBLIC DEFENDER BY COUNTIES; PRESCRIBING LIMITATIONS ON PRIVATE PRACTICE BY PUBLIC DE-FENDER, AND AMENDING SECTIONS 11-581 AND 11-583, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

Section 1. Section 11-581, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to read:

11-581. Public defender; appointment; joint office

- A. In any county with-a-population-of-one-hundred-thousand-persons or-more the board of supervisors may establish the office of public defender and appoint a suitable person to hold that office.
- B. TWO OR MORE COUNTIES MAY JOINTLY ESTABLISH ONE OFFICE OF PUBLIC DEFENDER TO SERVE SUCH COUNTIES.
- 10 Sec. 2. Section 11-583, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to 11 read:

11-583. Private practice of civil and criminal law prohibited

- A. IN A COUNTY OF THE FIRST CLASS HAVING A POPULATION OF SIXTY
 THOUSAND PERSONS OR MORE ACCORDING TO THE LAST OFFICIAL UNITED STATES
 CENSUS, the public defender shall not engage in the private practice of
 law.
- 8. The public defender shall not during his incumbency defend or assist in the defense of, or act as counsel for, any person accused of any crime in any county except as provided in this article.
